PRUDENTIAL RIDE LONDON REMINDER

SUNDAY 29th JULY 2018

King's Road and New King's Road will be closed from 7.30am until around 7.30pm. Vehicles will not be able to cross either road during the closure period, although there will be pedestrian crossing points. In theory vehicle access to and from our area over Wandsworth Bridge should only be for residents and their visitors. However, in past years there have been no controls at the south side of Wandsworth

Bridge, only a small notice, with the result that hundreds of drivers enter south Fulham and find themselves in an effective cul-de-sac. Gridlock results. PRARA has lobbied the organisers and the council for better stewarding to try and prevent this but so far with minimal improvements. Be warned!

CLANCARTY ROAD SCHOOL TRAFFIC

In spite of the schools best efforts, some of the parents and others who deliver children to or collect them from the Ecole and bi-lingual schools in powered vehicles cause serious traffic problems. It is a long standing issue for which, so far, no long term solution has been found. PRARA continues efforts to reduce the problem but measures taken so are very

limited by the availability of council officers and others and there is no lasting effect. The schools are limited in what they can do as they have no jurisdiction off school premises. We are currently investigating what additional measures might be possible.

NEIBOURHOOD WATCH

Sadly there has been an increase in crime in our area. This includes vehicle thefts (cars, motorbikes, mopeds and bicycles). Advice has already been sent out as how to best secure these possessions.

Keyless cars can easily have their signal copied. It is therefore important to keep your keys in a room at the back of the property and in a metal container, and also use a Crook lock on the steering wheel. Bikes should have two high quality locks and preferably be attached to an immovable object. Theft from cars is on the increase.

In view of this many of our members have suggested the installation of CCTV in the most vulnerable areas. We asked you all if you would be in favour of the PRARA Committee asking the Council to install cameras. We are extremely grateful to all those members who responded to this request.
